[ANDIES PRAIRIE SNO-PARK](#) | Sledding

An old rock pit shaped to provide a sled hill, pack your helmet as this is not your in-town slope. *(Oregon Sno-Park Pass)*

The Blues Crew maintains 16+ miles of groomed and non-groomed trails and leads signage and mapping efforts. *(Oregon Sno-Park Pass)*

**KNOW BEFORE YOU GO**—With several locations to enjoy a variety of snow sports, the Blue Mountains are a destination worthy of winter adventures. Please consult the blog for suggestions on how to monitor road conditions and snow reports. Typically, snow arrives in November and sticks around until April or May. Monitor the weather closely as conditions in the valley do not always mirror conditions in the mountains. Take a shovel, provisions, and warm clothing. Sno-park passes are state specific and required.
