Additional mountain bike trails are on the way with off-season access to Bluewood. Until then, add these trails to the ride list.

- ◆ The **Umatilla Rim Trail** is the workhorse multi-use mountain trail *(No Pass Required)*
- ◆ **Mount Emily Recreation Area** features 45 miles of trails *(Parking Permit)*
- ◆ **Bennington Lake** offers convenient, local trails for regular rides *(No Pass Required)*
- ◆ **Sinks Trail** is a ride through the forest that ends at a rope swing *(No Pass Required)*
- ◆ **Pendleton Adventure Trails Recreation Area (PATRA)** is a surprise in the desert with trails traversing the hills and a fun rhythm section *(No Pass Required)*
- ◆ **Sno Road Winery MTB Trail System** hosts the Red 2 Red XC race and provides shoulder season access to trails in Echo, Oregon *(No Pass Required)*
