WALLA WALLA WALKS | Arts, Trees & History

RECREATION IN TOWN | Hiking, Biking, Fishing, Discovering, Water Sports

Many of the **recreation opportunities in Walla Walla** are well suited for kiddos. These destinations are run by state and federal agencies, which means programming to engage their curiosity!

- ◆ **Whitman Mission** offers a junior ranger program & short, educational trails
- ◆ The **Fort Walla Walla Museum** is so engaging and houses two playgrounds
- ◆ **Mill Creek Recreation Trail** is paved and ready for bikes, rollerblades, scooters, etc.
- ◆ Enjoy a protected, paved lane in College Place on the **West Whitman Drive Path**
- ◆ **Bennington Lake** is a valley gem of recreation opportunities for the family

IN THE WILD | Hiking, Camping, Fishing, Discovering, Water Sports

Include kids in outdoor recreation. It really doesn't matter if you make it 100 feet from the trailhead or 10 miles down the trail. The goal has nothing to do with distance.

- ◆ **Lewis & Clark Trail State Park** has short, interesting trails & Touchet River access
- ◆ The **Umatilla Rim Trail** is perfect for first hikes and mountain bike rides
- ◆ Explore the **Rock Hill Trail** in Dayton to see the Jolly Green Giant
- ◆ **Lyons Ferry State Park** is at the confluence of the Snake & Palouse Rivers
